The Hawaii Friends of NRA is pleased to announce the 2017 NRA/CMP/USAS/JROTC Air Rifle and Rifle Coach Certification Course. The Coach Course is co-hosted by Island School, and the Hawaii Friends of NRA. The course credential earned is "Air Rifle and Smallbore Rifle Appointed Coach - Level 1", (three year term). This is the basic standard of certification in the combined National Rifle Association, USA Shooting, JROTC and Civilian Marksmanship Program sanctioned coach credential program.



The course will be taught by nationally recognized instructor Paul Davis of the National Coach Development Program. **This course is a non-profit activity for the purpose of raising the level of training, expertise, safety, and certification of our high school rifle team and community shooting programs and coaches.** This course is also appropriate for JROTC Instructors, Boy Scout Shooting Merit Badge counselors, Rodeo, and 4-H Air Rifle Program Leaders.

This year we are offering two class sections to help attendees minimize time away from work. **Section 1 will meet Monday to Thursday evenings July 24-27, 2017 (5:45PM - 9:45 PM)** at the Island School gym, 3-1875 Kaumualii Hwy, Lihue, HI 96766. **Section 2 will meet Thursday and Friday July 27-28, 2017 (8:30AM - 4:30PM) at the same location.**

Coaches completing the academic training successfully will gain hands-on coaching experience under the supervision of Coach Davis by serving as an assistant coach during one of two days of the Intermediate Junior Shooting Camp to be held during the weekend (July 29-30, 2017) at Island School gym and air rifle range.

The course fee is \$175 (includes instruction materials, binder, test and credential fee, and meals). The course is open to all adults (age 18+) and no prior coaching experience is required. Junior shooters aged 16-17 may complete the course and earn the Junior Coach Trainer credential. Junior Coach Trainer applicants must attach two letters of recommendation from a coach, teacher, or parent with their application.
